You can make your slides more accessible at your event by making a few simple updates so that they are inclusive for everyone at your event.

Images

- Add Alt text to Images & charts to allow all delegates to understand the images and charts fully if the image is decorative ensure you have stated this in set up.
- Keep descriptions concise.

- Make sure that any video or audio clips included in your presentation have subtitles or a transcript provided to ensure this content is accessible to everyone.
